- The application processing fee is \$150 for 3 choices. Each additional choice is \$50
- When choosing a program or school, consider pre-requisite courses, grade requirements, and costs.

You will need to have the following information in order to complete the step-by step application process through OUAC:

- OUAC PIN
- Personal data (name, address, date of birth, telephone number)
- Valid email address (not your SCDSB email address)
- Social Insurance Number
- Status in Canada
- Method of payment

Timeline

- Sept. to Nov. - Research programs, attend webinars and info sessions, follow Class of 2022 Google Classroom for dates and times
- Nov.- Near the end of the month OUAC application PIN numbers available from Guidance
- Jan. 13 - Deadline to submit application to the OUAC for equal consideration
 - initial application includes all final grades from Grade 11 and 12 courses and a list of all current courses in progress
- Jan. to May - Universities will send out rolling offers of admission, conditions may apply. Contact the university directly with questions
- June - may be required to respond to an Ontario University offer of admission and give a financial commitment

- It is important to check OUAC often to make sure marks are correct and all courses are accounted for. Students take courses through our school, online, night school and privately. If any marks or courses need to be added, please see Mr. Wallace and bring with you documentation of registration or report cards.
