University application fee :

\$156 for three program choices\$50 for each additional choice

College application fee:

*\$110 for five program choices with no more than three at any one college

DID YOU KNOW?

If you are interested in attending a postsecondary institution in the USA, you have to write a SAT or ACT admissions test. You need to register for test dates well in advance so check the College Board website for registration information

You should register now for a test date if you intend to apply for next September!

APPLYING OUT OF PROVINCE?

- YOU will need to contact each institution individually to obtain application information, due dates, etc. There are some exceptions such as UBC, McGill and Dalhousie which are connected to the OUAC.
- You will also need to ensure that
 YOU forward or <u>request</u> that we forward all required documentation by the appropriate deadlines (i.e. transcripts, reference letters, etc.)

- We're here to help but there is no centralized application process like Ontario, so you will need to be in charge of your application.

Taking Online Private Courses not in SCDSB?

When completing applications and selecting schools, include CCI to OCAS and OUAC as well as the <u>private institution</u>. This way the other schools will send marks automatically. You can also bring those marks to CCI Guidance.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

<u>COLLEGE</u>

- Colleges will look at your grade 11 & 12 marks which include your Gr.12 semester 1 mid-term and finals
- Some Colleges will use an average of your top 6 senior division marks and others will use your Gr. 12 English mark along with other prerequisite course marks
- Often, additional criteria are used such as interviews, assessment tests & portfolios

UNIVERSITY

- Completion of 6 Gr. 12 U or M pathway courses including ENG4U1 & other criteria such as portfolios & auditions
- Prerequisite courses are usually included in admission averages
- Gr.11 marks are used for early offers of admission
- Please note you cannot apply for early acceptance.
 Universities will give early
 - offers of admission based on marks at their discretion

Scholarships, Awards and Bursaries

Internal CCI Awards are determined by the awards committee and specific departments. The CCI Awards application will be available to students online in May.

Entrance Scholarships for individual Colleges and Universities are based on your entrance marks. Check with the Financial Aid office of the schools you apply to for details.

External Scholarships are offered nationwide and locally – most applications are online, apply for as many as you like. Be sure to check out the CCI Scholarship hand out as a guide to external scholarships as well as the websites provided in the "helpful websites" section.

Speak to your parents/guardians about possible company scholarships at their workplace.

Offers of Admission ALL OFFERS ARE CONDITIONAL

<u>COLLEGE</u>: most conditional offers will begin to be sent by mid to late February and will continue through to early June. Some offers will be sent as early as December.

UNIVERSITY: most Ontario Universities start sending their early conditional offers in February and then continue throughout the spring. Some conditional offers may be received as early as December.

<u>TIP</u>: apply early because Universities & Colleges start to process applications as soon as they are received.

TIP:

You should always have your **student reference number** available when speaking to postsecondary representatives regarding your application and write down a list of questions that you would like to ask before you call.
